Rogers Cable Changes

Rogers Cable has recently changed their programming to digital. **If you were receiving free cable you will no longer be able to do so.**

In order to get the channels that were previously available, you must contact Rogers and ask them for the new digital box. If you did not have an account with Rogers but your family member was receiving cable then you must set up a new account, **this is not paid for by River Glen.** You will have to contact Rogers and provide them with your information and ask Rogers to set up the digital box for your family member.

River Glen Haven is not responsible for the cable in the residents' rooms and does not set up the digital boxes in the residents' rooms. **The box must be installed by a Rogers Technician.**

River Glen Haven cannot contact Rogers on behalf of the residents, this must be done by the person whose name is on the bill or the person that will be the contact.
